Preparing For Your Arrival



Hold Types that Require Action

- Outstanding Balance
- Must See SFS
- Financial Withdrawal
- Health Forms/Health Clinic
- No Schedule

*Some holds that display are for tracking purposes and do not require action.

How to Clear Holds

- Resolve any outstanding balance on your student account
- Log into your Pyramed portal and complete the 4 required Health Forms, including uploading a copy of your immunization record, and your active health insurance card.
- Complete your course registration for the semester
 - Full Time students need minimum of 12 credits.
 - Required to move onto campus, play on sports team

Move-In Logistics

Move-In Times and Traffic Flow

- By August 14th, each student will receive an email with a specific move-in block. Typically blocks at 90 minutes long. The goal is to keep traffic, including traffic within the buildings, from getting gridlocked.
- After entering the main gate, cars will be directed to the tennis court lot for the first part of residential check in.
- If there are any holds for the student, the car will be directed to another lot to meet with the appropriate office to clear the hold
- If there are no holds, the car will be given a pass and directed to the appropriate residential unloading area
- At the residence hall, the student will receive a room key and our student athletes will help move things from the cars to the rooms
- Once unloaded, cars will moved away from building entrances to park

What to Pack (and What to Leave at Home)

- Full list at What to bring to campus when moving in | Curry College
- Items to consider
 - Bedding and pillow(s) (Extra-long twin mattress)
 - Shower and toiletries with something to carry them in
 - Laundry detergent (laundry is free, BYO detergent)
 - Desktop fan (even with a/c, it's nice to have air move around the room)
 - Command strips to hang things (not blue putty, which stains walls. Must remove command strips slowly to avoid damaging paint)
 - Surge protected power strip
 - First aid supplies (Tylenol, Aleve, band aids, etc.)
- Items to leave home
 - Younger siblings (can visit, but that's a bonus of going to college!)
 - o Irreplaceable or fragile valuables
 - Appliances with exposed heating elements (hot plates, Foreman grills, etc.)
 - Candles and combustibles
 - Pets, except non carnivorous fish
