



## 2025 Sexual Misconduct Survey Summary

In spring 2025, Curry College conducted its first Sexual Misconduct Campus Climate Survey to comply with the Massachusetts [2021 Campus Sexual Assault Law](#). The law directs public and private higher education institutions in Massachusetts to conduct a campus sexual misconduct survey no less than every four years and post results on their website within 120 days.

Students enrolled at Curry College received an email invitation from Grand River Solutions—a third-party research company hired by Curry—to participate in the anonymous survey. Grand River Solutions created the survey, which was determined to be exempt from the need for IRB review and approved for use by the Massachusetts Department of Higher Education. The survey was promoted via campus-wide email sent by Curry College's Vice President for Diversity, Equity and Belonging. Fliers posted in campus buildings and email reminders were sent to students during the survey administration. The survey was provided in both English and Spanish.

At the end of the survey, participants were given the opportunity to submit their contact information to enter a raffle to receive one of two 42-inch smart TVs. Participants' survey responses were not connected to this incentive in any way. Out of the 1,911 undergraduate and graduate students who were invited to take the survey, 211 (11%) completed the survey.
