Course Descriptions – Autism Specialist Certificate/ Autism Endorsement

SPE 6810 Understanding Autism Spectrum Disorder (3 credits)

Explore the causes and diagnoses of Autism, Asperger Syndrome, and Pervasive Developmental Disorder Not Otherwise Specified (PDDNOS), and their impact on learning and behavior.

SPE 6820 Effective Educational & Behavioral Strategies Designed to Instruct Students with Challenging Behaviors (3 credits)

Learn how to effectively engage and instruct students with challenging behaviors using differentiated strategies and assistive technology.

SPE 6830 Autism Spectrum Disorder: Diagnosis and Assessment (3 credits)

Plan and conduct assessments for students on the Autism Spectrum and learn how to monitor progress and modify behavior.

SPE 6840 Meeting the Needs of Students with Autism: A Collaborative Approach (3 credits)

Explore the roles of educational and medical professionals involved in the diagnosis, education, and treatment of students on the autism spectrum.

SPE 6845 Practicum & Seminar in Autism Spectrum Disorders (3 credits)

Apply knowledge and skills into real world practices by working with autistic students in inclusive and educational settings.

 - Teacher of the Visually Impaired
