Prerequisite courses for RN-BS Program:

BIOL 1075/1175	Anatomy and Physiology I (with lab)
BIOL 1085/1185	Anatomy and Physiology II (with lab)
BIOL 2010	Microbiology (with lab)
PSY 2400	Human Development
MATH 1150	Statistics

*These courses are usually transferable from your nursing program if taken at the college level. Speak with an advisor to review prerequisites eligible for transfer. You may be able to start your nursing courses at Curry with some prerequisites outstanding.

RN-BS Degree Requirements

To begin your studies, NSG 2100: RN Transition to Baccalaureate Nursing is required as the first course. Twenty-seven nursing credits, and other degree requirements are required for the RN-BS program. You must achieve a passing grade of "B-" (80) to pass all nursing courses:

- NSG 3132 Population Health in the Community for the RN Student
- NSG 3986 Senior Seminar: Synthesis of Nursing Practice for the RN Student

*Degree students will receive 34 nursing transfer credits upon successful completion of NSG 2100: RN Transition to Baccalaureate Nursing.
