Accelerated Entry MSN Curriculum

The Accelerated Entry MSN course load varies by semester and requires a full-time commitment. Attend hybrid classes over eight-week terms each semester - alongside related clinical coursework. During the last semester, students will participate in an immersive, clinical experience, complete a capstone project and receive preparation for the NCLEX-RN exam.

Application Requirements

- Completed application submitted online
- Current CV/Resume
- Personal Statement: 500 words
- Official transcripts from the institution(s) where you received your undergraduate degree and took prerequisite courses
- An earned baccalaureate degree from any undergraduate major with a minimum 3.0 GPA (3.3 GPA preferred)
- Successfully complete at least two of the four required science prerequisites (see below) before the application deadline for your application to be reviewed. All 6 prerequisite courses must be completed prior to entering the program.
- \$50 application fee paid to Curry College at curry.estore.flywire.com (Admission→Continuing Ed and Grad Admission→App Fee - ACCEL Nursing)

Prerequisite Courses (B- or higher)

(Science Courses must be within 10 years):

- Anatomy and Physiology I (4 cr. with lab)
- Anatomy and Physiology II (4 cr. with lab)
- Chemistry (4 cr. with lab)
- Microbiology (4 cr. with lab)
- Human Growth and Development (3 cr., non-science prerequisite)
- Statistics (3 cr., non-science prerequisite)
