The Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree is a 34-credit, 5-semester program. All classes are delivered in a hybrid format, combining live lectures (hyflex) with online activities. The actual schedule may vary based on holidays and other scheduling issues.

Unless noted, all classes are 3-credits each. Schedule is subject to change.

Application Deadline

To receive priority consideration, submit all materials by July 15 to begin in Fall. Applications received after July 15 will be reviewed on a space available basis.

MED Program Tuition

The MED program has instituted an attractive fixed tuition cost to help students better manage their tuition payments. Our fixed tuition allows students to enter the program knowing the full cost of their MED tuition and not be subject to an additional tuition increase as long as they remain enrolled in their original cohort group. The MED program charges no additional course fees. For planning purposes, the fixed tuition for M.Ed., PSL and CAGS students is \$557 per credit. Alumni pricing is available to those that qualify.

Tuition Billing Process

Approximately five weeks prior to the start of the fall, spring, and summer semesters, students will be mailed a tuition bill for their semester coursework. Tuition payments are due within 30 days of the billing date specified on the bill and must be paid in full prior to the start of each semester.

Curry College offers a Direct Billing option for students whose employer or other third party organization will be paying the College directly for their classes. Students who plan to use the direct billing option are required to provide appropriate documentation, such as a purchase order or voucher. Tuition Payment - Curry Student Accounts Portal

eChecks – Make payments quickly and easily with no service fee from your checking or savings account using a U.S. bank. You will need the routing number for your bank and your account number.

Credit Cards and Debit Cards - MasterCard, VISA, Discover or American Express accepted online with a 2.75% convenience fee assessed to each credit card or debit card transaction.

Pay by Monthly Payment Plan - Semester bills can be divided into four-month payments for eligible Graduate and ACCEL Nursing programs. There is a \$40 nonrefundable application fee per semester.

International Students - You can pay in your native language and currency with multiple payment options available. Curry College does not charge a transaction fee for this service; however, banks may charge a service fee. Log into the myCurry portal to see the payment options for your country.

Curry also partnered with Flywire for a payment portal that will allow you to pay for items not billed on your student account – Application fees, Admissions Deposits, Graduation Fees and all Continuing Education courses will now be paid through curry.estore.flywire.com.

Federal Student Loans
