Because of the Coronavirus threat, however, we must institute library policy changes.

Masks must be worn at all times in the library.

There will be an ID card check in system at the front library entrance.

We must reduce library capacity in accordance with state and local guidelines. Therefore, we are limiting seating at tables and computer work stations. Half of our computers will be taken offline to facilitate social distancing.

The lower level is now available for use in addition to the library main floor. You may request books for borrowing via Primo, the library's search engine and catalog, or from the library staff. For assistance with the ERC books on the main floor, please ask for help from a library staff member.

If you need reference or research help, a library staff person will direct you to a virtual reference station. Reference librarians are also available by chat, email, and virtual appointment.

We hope these restrictions will be temporary, and aim to provide a space for you that is a refuge from your classroom and dorm, as well as the chaos of our world. Even in this time of caution and increased vigilance, brought on by the threat of COVID-19, our library is a hub of learning, and a place for the nurturing of community.
