Choosing A Writing Course

WRIT 1400: Reading Writing Research I

WRIT 1400 is probably a good option for you. If you think you would benefit from extra one-on-one instruction, then WRIT 1200 is also a good option.

I've had issues with reading and writing and sometimes have trouble with these tasks. It feels like it takes me longer to finish assignments, and sometimes I need to ask for help from someone--a teacher, friend, or parent.

WRIT 1200: Reading Writing Research I PLUS (with Writing Studio)

WRIT 1200 is a good option for you because it gives you more opportunities to ask questions and get feedback from your Writing professor.

Reading and writing are a real struggle for me. I think I need lots of support to become a strong writer.

WRIT 1060 Academic Writing Process

WRIT 1060 is probably the best option because it provides an extra semester of practice and feedback.
