Curry College requires the completion of the Certification of Financial Resources from all international applicants who are not United States Citizens and will be seeking an F-1 Student Visa.

This form **MUST** be completed prior to the issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility Form I-20. The I-20 will not be issued until this certification is received by the Curry College Admission Office. **This form must also be accompanied by an official bank statement stating the availability of supporting funds in US Dollars.**

The statement must verify the availability of funds sufficient to the equivalent of one year of tuition, room, board, and all other applicable fees. The bank statement must include the current date, signature of bank official, and the financial institution's official stamp or seal.
