Congratulations on being admitted to Curry College! As an international student you will need to apply for a student visa in order to legally study in the United States. In order to obtain a student visa you will need to request an I-20 visa document from Curry. You must have this document to obtain a student visa.

F-1 Student Visa Information

Requirements to obtain F-1 Student status

- Student must be admitted to a full-time program of study leading to a specific educational objective
- Student must be proficient in English
- Student must show evidence of sufficient financial support

Types of Work Permitted

- On campus employment
- Curricular Practical Training (CPT)
- Up to 12 months of Optional Practical Training (OPT) per educational level which can be used before and/or after graduation

Dependents (Spouse/Family)

F-2 Visa holders

- Are not allowed to work
- May not attend school full-time. Part-time study must be recreational or vocational

SEVIS Fee

Beginning September 1, 2004, a new United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) rule went into effect. This rule requires F-1 applicants to pay a one-time fee of \$200 to supplement the administration and maintenance costs of the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS).
