

CURRY COLLEGE CONTINUING EDUCATION POLICY FOR VALIDATING HS DIPLOMAS - EFFECTIVE 7/1/2011

All students who apply for admission to a Bachelor's Degree program through Curry College's Division of Continuing Education and Graduate Studies will be required to provide a copy of either their official high school transcript that validates their graduation along with receipt of their high school diploma or a copy of their earned GED.

As required by Federal regulations, the Continuing Education Office will review all submitted documents to confirm authenticity and, if needed, may request additional documentation of the information provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) from the applicant or their respective institution. No financial aid can be disbursed to students without the College receiving documentation that validates high school graduation. All admissions documents from schools outside the United States must be translated and verified by an official translation service.
