Frequently Asked Questions about the Health and Immunization Requirements

How do I find the required forms?

- Sign into my.curry.edu using your curry email address and password
- In the Quicklinks section, scroll down (alphabetical) until you locate the Pyramed icon
- Click the Pyramed icon pyramen
- Click the MY FORMS tab to find the forms
- Click the DOCUMENT UPLOAD tab to upload required documents

Who has to submit vaccination information?

All undergraduate students including international students are required to complete the Curry College Immunization Form and to upload a copy of their official immunization record to the health portal.

Full-time students over the age of thirty (that are not in health sciences or nursing) are only required to complete the Curry College Tuberculosis Screening Form.

Nursing Graduate Students/ACCEL are required to complete the Curry College Immunization Form and the Curry College Tuberculosis Screening Form regardless of age. The Nursing Program has additional requirements for clinical rotations and these requirements will be managed by the Nursing Department.

Online Programs the above requirements apply if you will be on campus at any time (even once). If you are never on campus, these requirements do not apply.

How do I get my vaccination records?

- You can ask your healthcare provider for a copy, find a copy on your health care portal (MyChart.Epic), or get a copy from a national or state registry. If you had a physical exam recently, your immunization record is often attached to your physical.
- Your immunization record needs to have your full name, date of birth, name and date
 that vaccines was given AND provider/clinic signature, stamp or letterhead. A picture
 of your verified immunization record with provider/clinic information is acceptable
 BUT multiple screen shots from your phone without your identifying information or
 provider information are not acceptable.
- Your record needs to be uploaded to the health portal
- If you cannot locate your immunization records but know that you have received the required vaccinations, you will need to have antibody titers done, see the immunization from for details. Titers for Tdap and Meningococcal are not available so these vaccinations must be obtained.

I did not get the Meningitis ACWY Vaccination at age 16, what should I do?

- You can schedule an appointment with your PCP or at a local pharmacy to get this
 vaccination before starting Curry. Upload documentation of the vaccination to the
 health portal once you have received it.
- OR you can sign the Massachusetts State Meningococcal Waiver form. See Additional Forms to obtain this form.

Is Meningitis B vaccination required?

 Meningitis B vaccination is recommended but not required. Meningococcal B vaccinations (Bexsero, Trumenba) do not fulfill the requirement for meningococcal ACWY vaccination.

How do I request exemption from an immunization requirement?

- You may request exemption from one or more vaccine by completing the Curry College Student Vaccination Exemption Request Form. See Additional Forms section for this form.
- Medical exemption requests include completion of the required form AND a signed letter from a healthcare provider. The letter must state which immunization (s) cannot be given and certify that the student's health would be endangered or compromised by the immunization.

 Religious exemption requests include completion of the required form AND a written statement as to why the receipt of a vaccine or immunization would conflict with or violate sincerely held religious beliefs.

What happens if I answer "YES" to any questions on the Tuberculosis Screening form?

- Any "Yes" response requires additional Tuberculosis (TB) evaluation and testing.
- If there is a "YES" the student should print out the Curry College Tuberculosis (TB) Medical Provider form (See Additional forms section) and schedule a visit with their healthcare provider. The form will need to be completed and signed by the healthcare provider and the student will need to get a TB test (skin test or blood test). The form and result of the TB test will need to be uploaded to the portal.
- If you answered "YES" to any of the TB screening questions and DO NOT follow steps, above, Curry Health Center will email you to remind you that they are required.

What happens if I don't complete the vaccinations forms/upload my record?

• Failure to complete the required forms and supply the required documents may result in a delayed move-in process and/or registration hold.

Immunization forms and requirements are due by July 15th, 2025 for fall semester.
